

SAFE DESIGN OF LOADING AREA

FOR THE HOUSING UNIT

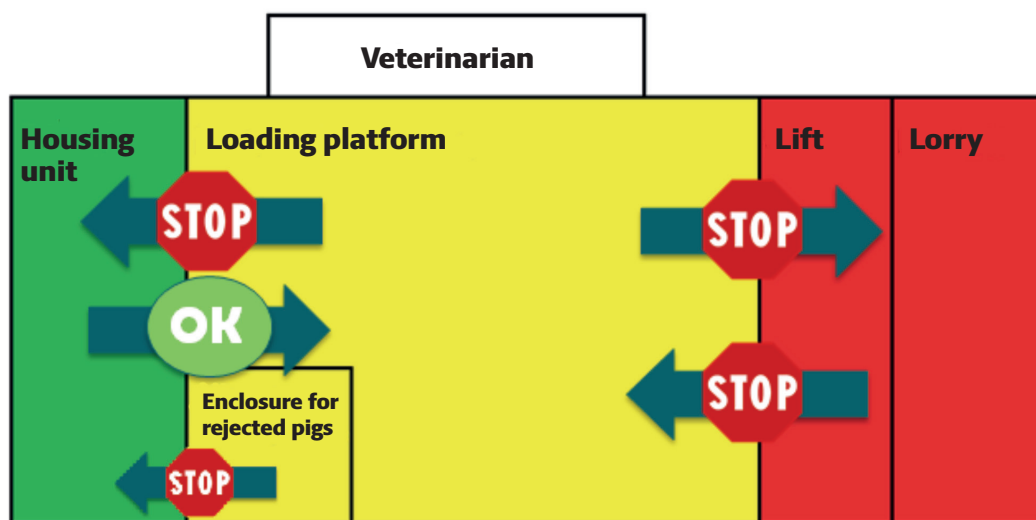
Clear markings showing where stockmen are allowed to go

- Stockmen are allowed to move freely throughout the housing area
- Stockmen may enter the loading area, but may NOT re-enter the unit afterwards
- Nobody is allowed to go from the loading area and into the housing unit. Instead, they have to go through the outer room and change their overalls, boots and wash their hands.
- Stockmen are not allowed to set foot on the lift or lorry

FOR THE HAULIER

Clear markings showing where the haulier is allowed to go

- Hauliers are allowed to move freely on and around the lorry and lift
- Hauliers are NOT allowed to enter the loading area



OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

- Plan out an area of no less than one square meter with solid flooring, where the driver can change clothes
- Erect signs to clearly show the driver the access road and loading platform
- Install Wi-Fi to enable the veterinarian to make instant changes to reported pig movements

PRACTICAL MEASURES

- Marking may be carried out using:
 - Signs and floor markings: "Entry prohibited" signs can be ordered at vsp.lf.dk under "Services"
 - Colour-coded clothing: Red overalls and red wellington boots may, for example, be worn on the loading platform, while another colour may be used for the housing unit.
- The best idea is to get all farm workers together and agree on what methods work best on your farm. For instance, you can draw up your own guidelines for loading procedures, which are adapted to your existing procedures.
