

## H15 - Danish Crown contract: All in / All out



### All in / All out contract:

1. Basic weight: 70.0 to 90.9 kg.
2. Deduction for overweight increases in intervals of DKK 0.20.
3. Normal deductions for underweight.
4. Settlement of 3 weeks' price average.
5. One contract per CHR number.
6. Max. 17 pick-up weeks a year. After that DKK 1,000 per pick-up week.
7. The contract is profitable for small producers with All in / All out at site level.
8. Possibility of a higher slaughter weight without increased weight deduction.

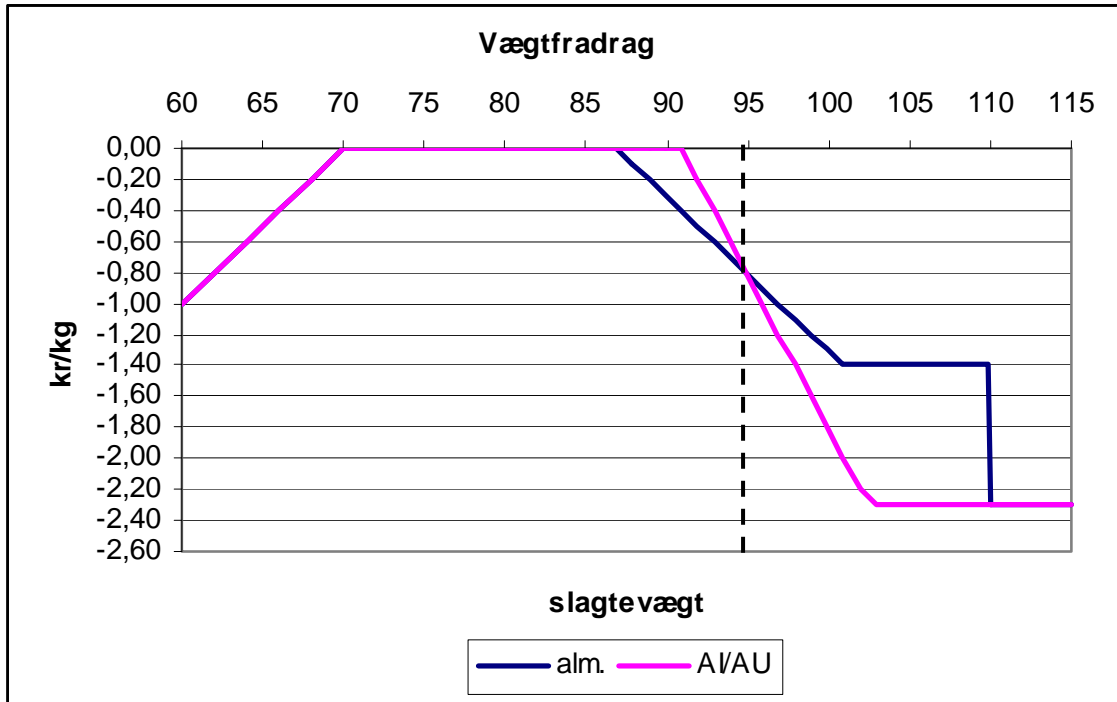


### The contract is not applicable if

- The pig producer / the company is entitled to DC Marked.

**Additional comments - Danish Crown contract: All in / All out**

A slaughter weight of 95 kg: the weight deduction per kg is identical for the two types of calculation.

- 4. Average of the pig price in pick-up week, the week before and the week after. Payment usually takes place no later than the Wednesday following the pick-up.
- 6. Two loads picked up in the same week only count for one.
- 8. In some cases, it may be an advantage to skip a week with this contract if only few pigs are ready for pick-up.  
The contract may still be attractive if more than 17 weeks of pick-up are needed; typically pig producers with a production of 5,000-8,000 pigs who do not operate with All in / All out at site level.

NB: Always check the producer's options in the environmental approval.  
Will postponed pick-up / increased gain be enough to reach a higher weight?
